Must-Know Reasons for implementing

Segregation of Duties

- To reduce the risk of errors: Separating key tasks among different individuals results in less errors.
- To prevent unauthorized activities: Ensuring SOD prevents malicious entities from making unauthorized changes.
- To improve accountability: Having SOD makes it easier to identify who is responsible for any issues that may arise.

• To enhance security: Implementing SOD improves security by restricting access to sensitive information.
